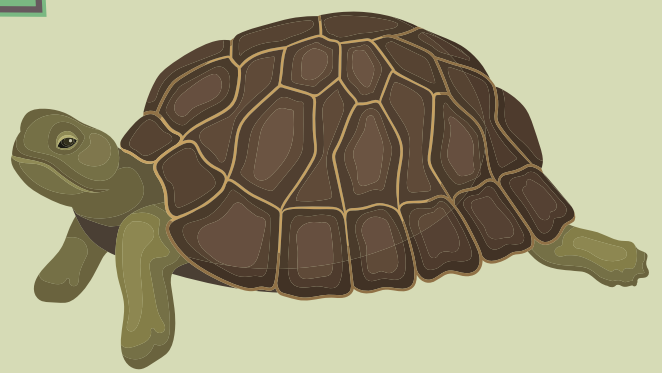


DESERT TORTOISE WEEK 2022

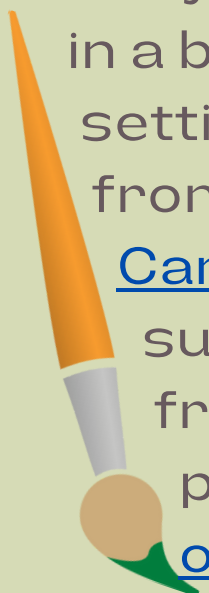
WEDNESDAY
